By recycling, we can reduce the exploitation of non-renewable natural resources and save energy

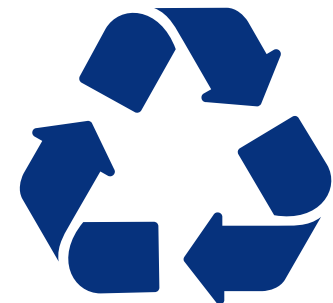
No trash, please

Cardboard boxes

Remove any packing materials such as foam, styrofoam peanuts, & bubble wrap. Please flatten boxes.



Aluminum cans & food cans

Rinse clean. Paper labels are ok. Place lid inside can & pinch end closed to keep lid inside.



Plastic bottles & jugs

All #1 & #2 plastic bottles, such as milk jugs, water bottles, pop bottles, and detergent bottles are accepted. Please rinse bottles.
